## Prospect Recreation & Park District Master Plan

Prospect Recreation & Park District (PRPD) is pleased to announce that Great Outdoors Colorado (GOCO) has awarded a Planning Grant to PRPD for its Master Plan Update project. As outlined in the Spring 2018 PRPD newsletter, the Master Plan update will consist of three components:

- 1. Update of the 2008 Master Plan. This will be a comprehensive evaluation of PRPD's parks, recreation facilities, and services.
- 2. Master Plan the Applewood Golf Course
- 3. Develop a conceptual plan for the Prospect Arena site

PRPD has selected GreenPlay LLC as the consulting firm that will perform the Master Plan update. GreenPlay completed PRPD's 2008 Master Plan, and is a nationally recognized firm in the planning field for park and recreation agencies. GreenPlay assists public agencies and other organizations across the nation with all aspects of the master and strategic planning process, including needs assessment, public process, level of service analysis, trends, demographics, financial and funding analysis, core services identification, operational and maintenance planning, strategic goals setting, and implementation for all quality of life services.

PRPD will seek focus group participants to assist in evaluating park and recreation services within the PRPD community. The focus group results will be used by the District to shape the development of a Master Plan for its parks, recreation facilities, trails, and services. Focus groups will take place at various times in late October with a public meeting also taking place in late October. Focus group participants will include residents, partner agency/organization representatives, business community representatives, and users of facilities and services.

The focus group participants will be asked to weigh in on the extent to which PRPD parks, recreation facilities, programs, and services meet the needs of the community. Participants will also be asked to weigh in on the community's perception of needs for future facilities, amenities, services, and programs.

GreenPlay will conduct the focus groups and the public meeting. For more information, please contact Keri Konold, Project Consultant at kerik@greenplayllc.com or 720-891-6663. Additionally, PRPD will soon be launching a new website; the new website will have a Master Plan update specific page with detailed information regarding public meetings and Plan progress. PRPD has successfully accomplished many of the goals and objectives in the 2008 Master Plan. We very much look forward to undertaking the Master Plan update project and creating a comprehensive guideline for our future.

### Maple Grove Park Playgrounds

The playgrounds at Maple Grove Park will undergo a total renovation this fall. All of the existing playground structures will be removed and brand new equipment will be installed. The design features a variety of unique and fun play pieces. Some very special custom pieces will provide the playgrounds with a whimsical theme that ties into the character of the Applewood neighborhood and the Clear Creek Valley. The layout will remain the same, with the north play pod being the 2 to year old play area and the south play pod for ages 5 to 12. The playground surfacing will be poured-in-place, a big improvement over the current engineered wood fiber material. Poured-in-place is a safe, attractive, and durable material that requires virtually no maintenance.

### **Strippgen Property**

#### Parking Lot Project

Construction is progressing on the shared use parking lot on PRPD's Strippgen property at 5550 Indiana Street. This project is a partnership between PRPD and Jefferson County Open Space (JCOS). The parking lot will allow visitors to access both JCOS's Van Bibber Park and the Strippgen property. Final completion is expected later this fall.





#### Strippgen Property Design Plan

PRPD issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) to create a design plan for the Strippgen Property, and will soon be selecting a consultant for this project. The consultant will create a design plan that is concise, user friendly, and visionary with regards to the unique aspects of the site. The consultant will collect and analyze data, meet with the District Board, Prospect Foundation Board, District staff, and community stakeholders to develop a comprehensive design plan. The goal of this project is to allow the District to undertake construction in 2019 of amenities such as trails, bird watching areas, and other improvements that will allow for passive recreational uses on this wonderful open space property.


