PRPD RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Park areas are open to the public from 5am – 9pm.
 2. Overnight stay is prohibited on any park area except when such activity is authorized in writing by District Manager.
 3. Dogs must be leashed and under control by the owner at all times.
 4. Glass beverage containers are prohibited. Beer and Wine are permitted and may be consumed by persons permitted by applicable state law with prior District approval.
 5. Fires are permitted only in existing fireplace grills using charcoal. No fire shall be left unattended; and any fire shall be completely extinguished prior to leaving the area.
 6. Motorized vehicles must remain on designated roadways and parking areas at all times.
 7. All trash, litter or refuse is to be placed in the provided trash receptacles. No dumping allowed.
 8. Amplification systems are prohibited except when such activity is authorized in writing by the District Manager.
 9. Hazardous Activities – It shall be unlawful for any person to engage in any activity on any park lands which constitutes a hazard to the safety of self or other persons, except in areas where such activity is specifically authorized.
 10. It is unlawful to launch or discharge any type of missiles; or operate any remote controlled surface, water, aircraft devices; or hot air balloons except when authorized by the District Manager.
 11. The use of any weapons including firearms, B-B guns, pellet guns, bows or slingshots is strictly prohibited.
 12. Use of fireworks is strictly prohibited.
 13. It is unlawful to conduct any commercial activity, or provide any service or activity for which a fee is charged, except when such activity is authorized in writing by the District Manager.
 14. It is unlawful to remove, damage, destroy, deface or otherwise vandalize any park property, structure, sign, or vegetation on District park lands.
 15. It is unlawful to hunt, trap, harass or harm any wild animal, bird or plant life on District park lands.
