

Prospect Recreation & Park District awarded Grant from Statewide Internet Portal Authority!

Prospect Recreation & Park District (PRPD) has been awarded a \$5,800 grant from the Colorado Statewide Internet Portal Authority. The Statewide Internet Portal Authority (SIPA) was created in 2004 by an act of the Colorado State Legislature (C.R.S. 24-37.7-113) to provide efficient and effective e-Government services for eligible governmental entities and citizens through the use of modern business practices and innovative technology solutions. Eligible governmental entities include state and local governments, school districts, and other eligible entities within the State of Colorado. SIPA is a guasi governmental body corporate, governed by a 13-member Board of Directors.

SIPA's Micro-grant program is designed to accelerate the adoption of electronic government services by placing more Colorado government services and information online. PRPD's grant award will allow PRPD to move forward with the development of an online reservation scheduling component. Once the reservation scheduling component is fully operational, park users will be able to reserve the Arbor House, Kendrick Cottage, or a park pavilion online.

If all proceeds as planned, the new reservation capability should be operational in mid to late summer. Please check **www.prospectdistrict.org** for further updates.

PRPD extends its thanks to SIPA for this grant award. SIPA received over 60 applications from all across Colorado for this Micro-Grant cycle- PRPD was one of 22 successful applicants. The ways in which these grant awards will be used by the successful applicants is truly amazing.
